In 2 months, UP police reunite 96 missing kids with families

WHEN POLICE in Gautam Buddha Nagar started Operation Muskaan on June 18, even thev couldn't imagine they would be able to reunite 96 children with their families.

The operation, which continued till August 18, was launched by the Uttar Pradesh DGP to bring families together.

The families of 53 boys and 43 girls, mostly between the ages of five and fifteen, and kept in various child shelters across the state. were traced by nine teams — one from the district's anti-human trafficking unit (AHTU) and one each under the eight circle officers in the district.

"At the start of the operation, we had 135 missing children cases registered in our police stations. Twenty have been resolved through the operation, and the rest are children who had been missing from different districts or whose cases had not been registered," said SP Crime Ashok

According to an AHTU official, the standard procedure the teams have been following is visiting state-run and state-sponsored child shelters and trying to get the children to recollect the area of their homes. Once a child names an area, they ask the police station concerned if any missing child complaints have been lodged there. According to the official, the youngest children they

have been able to rescue are fiveyear-olds. "The difficulty with cases of children younger than that is that they are unable to communicate with us or remember their homes. Another major difficulty arises when parents don't file complaints with police, in which case we have to ask around the area with a picture of the child," he said.

A particularly difficult case was that of 13-year-old Sunny, who had been missing for seven years. According to police, Sunny's father, a guard, had been arrested in relation to a petty theft, while his mother ran off with another man. It was during this period that he was lured to Budaun by a man who made him work as a household help.

He managed to escape in a few months and spent three years on the move, until he was taken into a child shelter home in Budaun, where he spent four years. "In the meantime, his father got out of prison and on finding no one at their Noida home, moved elsewhere. The fact that he had been missing for a long time and was in a shelter home in another district, and that no one had filed a missing person complaint earlier... made the case very tough..." said an AHTU official.

Meanwhile, parents of another 12-year-old expressed apprehensions. "This is the third time he has gone missing in the last one-and-a-half years. He is a little mentally unstable and goes wandering off," said the boy's fa-

Expert panel will be set up for solid waste management: L-G to SC

LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR Anil Baijal Monday informed the Supreme Court that an expert committee would be constituted to deal with all aspects relating to solid waste management in the national capital.

A bench of Justice Madan B Lokur, Justice S Abdul Nazeer and Justice Deepak Gupta observed that the issue of solid waste management in the city was "serious" and said the committee would have to meet on a day-today basis to take stock of the situation.

Additional Solicitor General (ASG) Pinky Anand, appearing for the L-G's office, and senior advocate Colin Gonsalves, who is assisting the court as an amicus curiae, placed before the bench the names of persons who could be made members of the committee.

The ASG said that persons engaged in business enterprises or having any commercial interest should not be made members of the panel and the names suggested by them should also have people from the resident welfare association (RWAs).

"How often are they (committee) going to meet? They will have to meet every day," the bench observed.

"It (meeting) has to be on a day-to-day basis. They have to visit the sites, find out what needs to be done. It will not be a bureaucratic kind of a committee. The issue is serious," the bench observed.

During the hearing, the bench observed that bureaucrats would be there in the committee and the members should try to "work together" to deal with the serious issue.

The bench asked the ASG and the amicus to find out whether the persons, who are residing outside Delhi and whose names have been suggested for the committee, could do this work on a day-to-day basis.

"They will have to come every day for meetings. You will have to give them office space. Almost 20 persons are there. It is a serious thing and not a onetime thing," the bench said.

The amicus told the court that he would find out from those residing outside Delhi as to whether they could attend the meetings daily.

At the end of hearing, the amicus said travelling expenses and hotel costs for those committee members, who are residing out of Delhi, should be given. The bench fixed the matter for further hearing on August 29.

In murder of 17-yr-old, poem emerges as crucial evidence

"I WISH I were dead, every time I close my eyes, I see dark paradise. I am tired of being here, suppressed by my own fears... We went from playing with our toys to become toys ourselves. So boys will be boys and we women will never tell."

This extract from a poem by Shreya Sharma (17), murdered last year by her school senior, is part of the evidence produced in a Delhi court to show the "suffering and agony" she faced.

Additional Sessions Judge Virender Kumar Bansal read out the poem as part of his order, while handing out life imprisonment to the convict Sarthak Kapoor. In an earlier hearing, the court had said: "It is a case of jilted lover who wanted deceased back at any cost. He applied all tactics, extended threats, but when he did not succeed in getting her



The poem was also sent for forensic analysis and the handwriting expert opined that Sharma had written it, court records show.

Sharma, a Class XII student was choked to death in Rohini's Sector 17 on August 16 last year by Kapoor, who was 19 at the time. Her body was found in a narrow lane near her home. The court, while convicting Kapoor, had said he used to frequently harass her.

During the hearing on the quantum of sentence, the counsel for the convict said he is 19 years old with no previous criminal record. He also said he is a good student and the murder was not planned. However, the prosecutor said the murder created a void in the girl's family, which "cannot be filled". The prosecutor also said it was a "gruesome murder" and prayed for severe punishment. ASJ Bansal asked the convict

if he wanted to say anything, but he refused.

The court then said: "It was a well-planned cold-blooded murder. He communicated with her on Instagram his intentions to kill her, and executed the same as a professional in a cold-blooded manner without using a weapon. Keeping in view of the facts, and at the same time that he is of young age and the case that does not fall within the rarest of rare category, the convict is sentenced to rigorous life imprisonment..."

25-year-old raped and strangulated, police say relationship gone sour

A 25-YEAR-OLD woman was allegedly beaten up, raped and strangulated to death in northeast Delhi by two persons, including a man with whom she had been in a relationship for 10 months, police said, adding that both accused have been arrested.

On Saturday morning, the unclothed body of a woman was found in the backyard of Dr Bhim Rao Ambedkar College, following which her body was sent for postmortem. Police also found two names tattooed on her left arm her own and one Ashish. "Police checked all missing complaints from nearby areas, but did not get any leads, after which they circulated her photo to informers," a senior police officer said.

Police said a vital clue came on Sunday morning, after an informer identified the woman. "Police found where she had been staying and eventually discovered that she was dating an auto-rickshaw driver named Ashish," an officer said.

DCP (northeast) Atul Kumar Thakur said, "We have arrested two persons, Ashish (24) and Mohammed Saif (19), both autorickshaw drivers, after registering an FIR under IPC sections 302

idence)." Several raids were conducted and police detained Ashish. "Ashish disclosed to police that he met the woman around a year ago. Eventually, they entered into a relationship," police said. Ashish claimed things became tense when she started pressuring him for marriage.

"On Friday, she threatened his family to approve of their relationship. He then, with his friend Saif, met her Saturday night, and tried to convince her to drop the idea. But when she wasn't convinced, the duo physically assaulted her and Ashish allegedly raped her, after which they stran gulated her to death and dumped her body in a garbage area," an officer said.

Thakur said, "We have conducted the post-mortem but are yet to receive the autopsy report.
